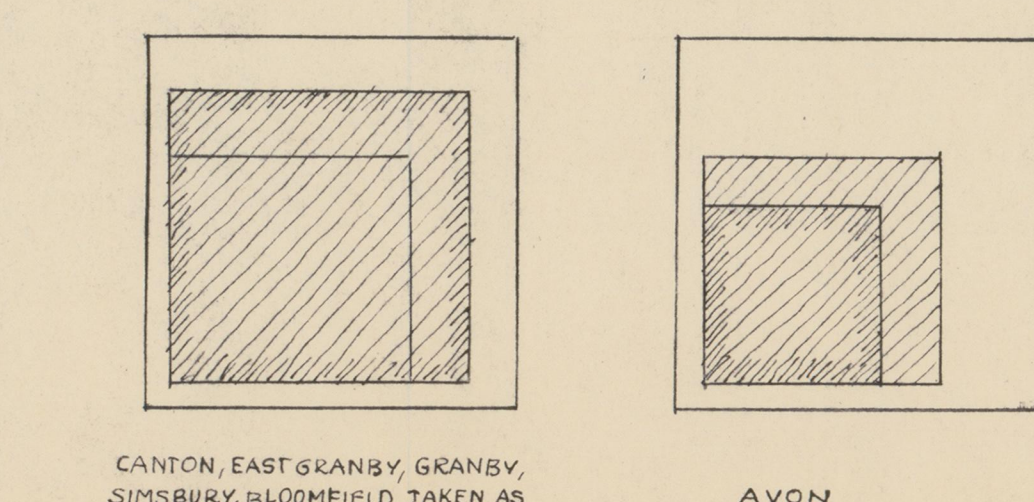

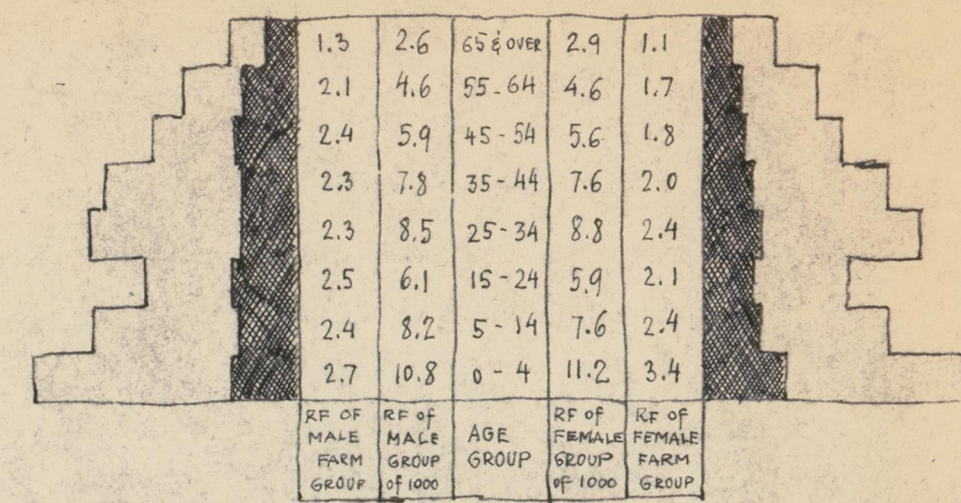
FARM POPULATION OF AVON IN AGE GROUPS
SUPERIMPOSED OVER THE AVON AGE-POPULATION PYRAMID



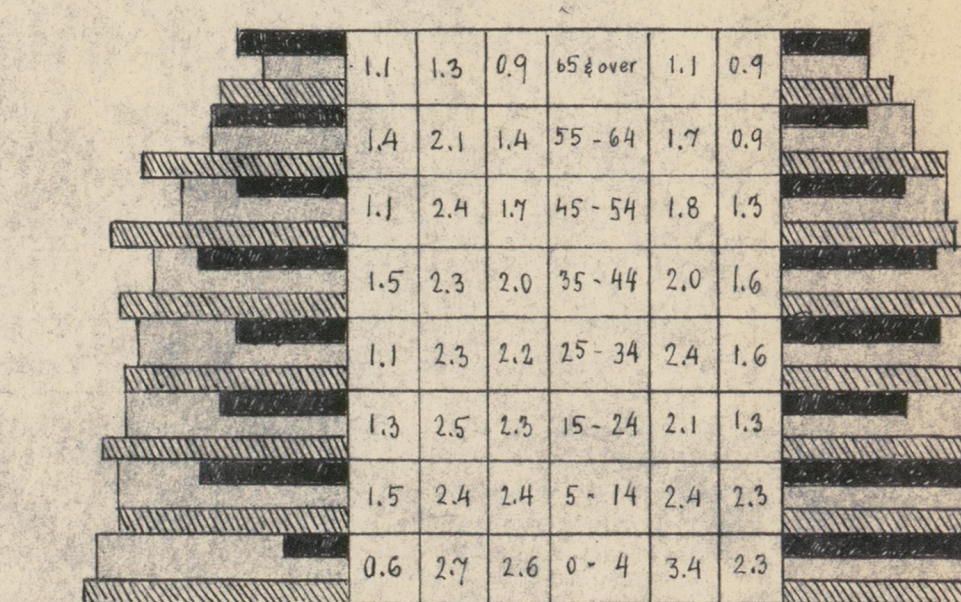
TRANSFORMATION OF THE THEORETICAL PROFILE

COMPENSATION ACT SUPERIMPOSED OVER THEORET. SQUARE IN GROUPS OF 1000



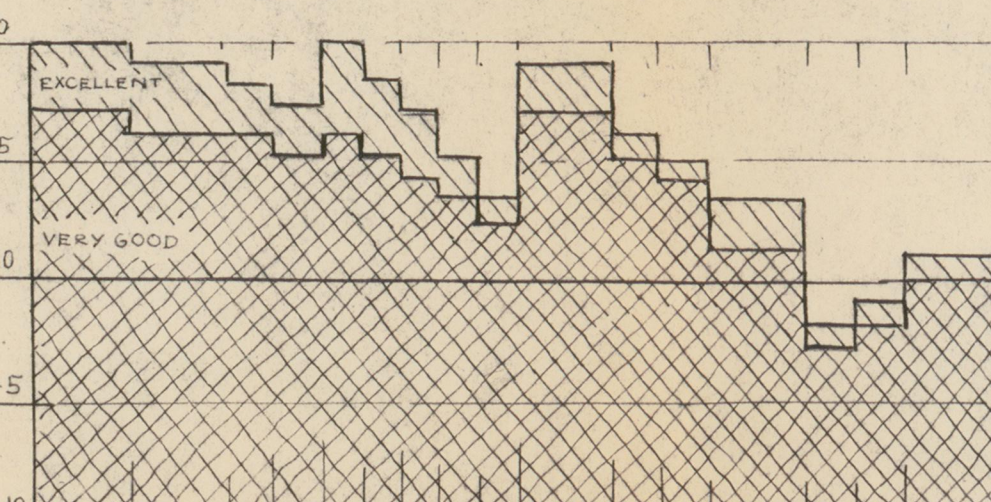

OVER THE POPULATION-AGE PYRAMID



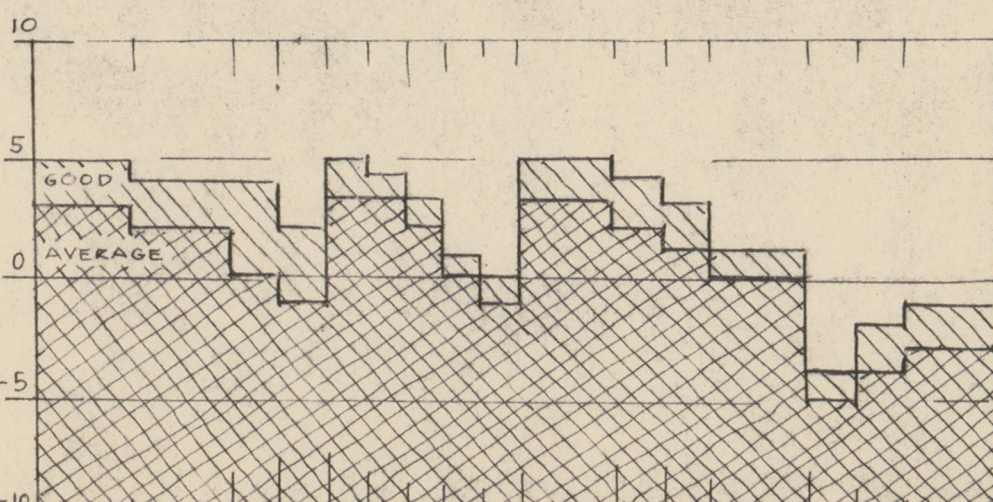

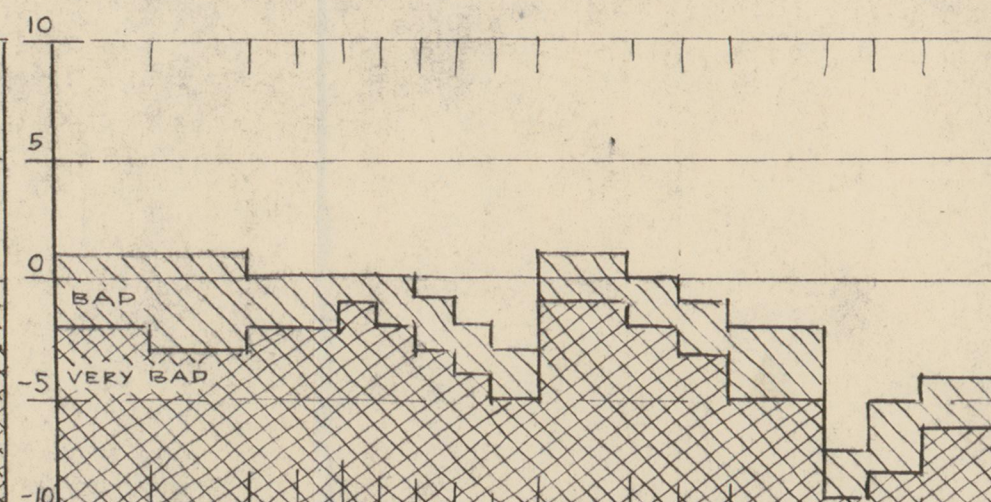

MIDDLE CLASS LIVING CONDITIONS

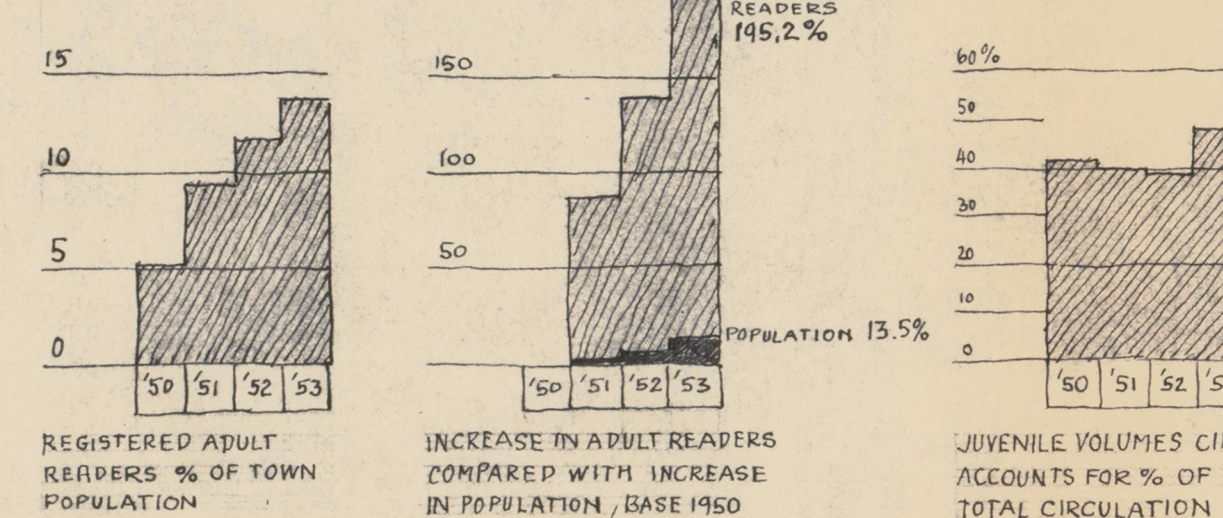

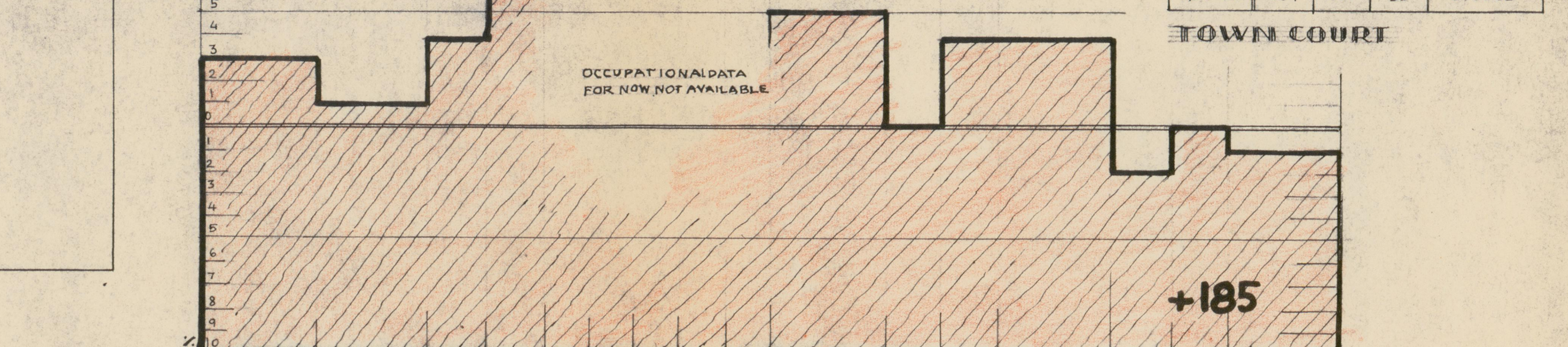
