



## **Avon Town Manager Receives Designation**

The International City/County Management Association has awarded Avon Town Manager Brandon Robertson its prestigious “Credentialed Manager” designation. ICMA is the primary professional association for local government managers. To receive the ICMA credential, a member must have significant experience as a senior management executive in local government; have earned a degree, preferably in public administration or a related field; and demonstrated a commitment to high standards of integrity and to lifelong learning and professional development. Robertson joins a select group of about a dozen “Credentialed” managers in Connecticut.

Robertson, town manager in Avon since January 2010, previously worked for the towns of Tolland and Simsbury, CT. “I am both honored and humbled to receive Credentialed Manager Status. I am proud to put these skills to work for the Town of Avon. It’s a wonderful community and I am very proud to have the opportunity to live and work here,” Robertson said.

Town Council Chair Mark Zacchio and Board of Finance Chair Tom Harrison issued a joint statement congratulating Robertson on his award: “Brandon has served the people of Avon with great skill and dedication, and we are delighted that his professional peers have recognized what we have known all along. Congratulations to him and his family.”

The “Credentialed Manager” designation was awarded to Robertson at the ICMA’s annual conference, which was held this year in Seattle in September.
