RE: Sanitary Sewer Study in your Neighborhood

Dear Homeowner,

The Town of Avon Sewer Department is about to enter the spring phase of the Infiltration and Inflow study of Avon's sewer service area which flows to Farmington. Town staff has been working with an Engineering consultant (Fuss & O'Neill, Inc.) to gather field data about the sewer system.

This spring phase will involve examination and flow testing of specific neighborhood sanitary sewer areas for excessive storm water and groundwater leaks. These extraneous flows directly increase the sanitary sewer flows resulting in additional treatment costs paid by Avon's residents.

The sewer evaluation will occur during both day and overnight hours during the months of April, May, and June. The work being done will not affect your sewer lateral nor will sewer service be interrupted. At no point will there be a need to access private homes or contact homeowners directly during this work.

The overnight work will occur between the hours of 10:00 pm and 5:00 am over a period of several nights. Sanitary sewer flow late at night is primarily from storm water and groundwater leaks. Locating this extraneous flow is easiest when people are asleep and not using their sinks, baths, or toilets.

The work requires opening numerous sewer manholes. Many of the manholes are located in or adjacent to streets, while others are located within off-road easements in side/back yards of private property. The primary work impact will be slow moving vehicles with flashing yellow lights and individuals working next to the sewer manholes.

The team performing the work will consist of 3 to 6 individuals with support vehicles, each of whom will have proper identification. The Avon Police Department are aware of the work area and schedule and will be present during a portion of the work. The work will begin in the Hastings Turn/Country Club area and then commencing north to the Avonridge area. The work will begin the week of 4-13-15 and is somewhat weather dependent (we're hoping for rain).
