### AVON POLICE DEPARTMENT CALEA ACCREDITATION ON-SITE ASSESSMENT

The Avon Police Department is scheduled for an on-site assessment (from February 28, 2016 through March 2, 2016) as part of a program to achieve accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session at the Avon Senior Center on Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at 5:30 pm. The Avon Senior Center is located at 635 West Avon Road, Avon, Connecticut.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (860) 409-4212 on Monday, February 29, 2016 between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the public information session, are limited to 10 minutes and must address the Police Department's ability to comply with CALEA standards.
