Avon Police Department Procedure for Obtaining a Raffle, Bazaar, or Cow-Chip Permit

1. **Traditional Raffles** : If you are conducting a Raffle in the Town of Avon, the following forms are required:

CGR-2

Once a raffle has been held, you must submit a Verified Raffle Statement. Form **CGF-7**

2. **Bazaar**: If you are conducting a Bazaar in the Town of Avon, the following forms are required:

CGR-2

CGR-2A

CGR-2B

Once the Bazaar has been held, you must submit a Verified Bazaar Statement. Form **CGF-6**

3. **Cow-Chip Raffle**: If you are conducting a Cow-Chip Raffle in the Town of Avon, you must submit the following forms:

CGR-2

CRG-2A

CGR-2C

Once a Cow-Chip raffle has been held, you must submit a Verified Raffle Statement. Form **CGF-7**

****Along with your application, please include a copy of Raffle ticket and Payment fees to the Town and State. Please make payments payable to: Treasurer, State of CT**

****Below are Payments per Class types:**

Raffle/Bazaar Class Types

Class 1: Up to \$15 thousand dollars in prizes
Up to 3 months to sell
Fees: \$25 to State, \$25 to Town

Class 2: Up to \$2 thousand dollars in prizes
Up to 2 months to sell
Fees: \$10 to State, \$10 to Town

Class3: Bazaars Only
Bazaars can last up to 10 days
Fees: \$10 to State, \$10 to Town

Class 4: Up to \$100 in prizes
Up to 1 month to sell
Fees: \$5 to Town

Class 5: Up to \$50 thousand dollars in prizes
Up to 9 months to sell
Fees: \$40 to State, \$40 to Town

Class 6: Up to \$100 thousand dollars in prizes
Up to 1 year to sell
Fees: \$50 to State, \$50 to Town
