



On **Tuesday, May 17<sup>th</sup>**, the Avon High School Booster Club will host the 23rd annual **Richard Migli Golf Tournament** in honor of the talented Falcon athlete who died in 1993 after a courageous battle with Lou Gehrig's Disease (ALS). The event will be held at the Golf Club of Avon and is made possible by title sponsor Northwest Community Bank; gold sponsors Avon Plumbing and Heating, Eversource Energy, Lawrence Brunoli, Inc., and Yamin & Grant, LLC, and many generous business and individual donors from the community. All area golfers and sports enthusiasts are invited to attend.

A member of the class of 1970, Richard (Dick) Migli was a standout athlete who excelled in football, basketball and baseball, earning twelve varsity letters and a place in the hearts of his teammates, coaches and fans. The tournament bearing Dick's name was created through a partnership between the Migli family and the Avon Booster Club in 1993. All proceeds from the event directly benefit Avon student-athletes by funding supplemental equipment, resources and scholarships, including two signature, honorary Dick Migli Scholarships awarded to graduating student-athletes who (as Dick did) demonstrate a 'zest for life'.

The Migli golf tournament regularly draws a sell-out crowd of golfers, diners and donors eager to keep Dick's legacy alive and help current and future AHS athletes. The 2016 planning committee invites sports fans from the greater community to join the fun as golfer (9 or 18 holes), diner and/or donor at this year's tournament.
