To the Avon Community,

The drainage work and mill and overlay of Stagecoach, Woodmont and Briar Hill Roads have been completed. The final work of the season will be the completion of a mill and overlay of Cliff Drive, Frandel, and a portion of Pioneer Drive. The Department also expects to complete an overlay of Cider Brook Road and Thompson Road from the intersection with Old Farms to, approximately, the intersection with the Rail Trail.

All paving work is expected to be completed by the middle of October. In all, 8.3 miles of Town road have been improved since the spring.

The Avon Water Company project to replace the mains on the west side of West Avon Road is progressing according to schedule. It is anticipated that the project will be complete by mid-November.

The pool at Sycamore closed the day after Labor Day. Improvements to the pool will begin shortly. Improvements have been made at the Buckingham Fields. Dug out covers have been installed and batting cages will be ordered soon.

Also, you may want to start thinking ahead....the second Household Hazardous Waste Collection event of the season is scheduled for November 7<sup>th</sup>. The event will be held at the Simsbury Public Works Facility at 66 Town Forest Road and will be open from 8:00 a.m.-12:00 noon. Details are posted on the Town's web site.

On the development front, you may be aware that the Avon Village Center Plan was adopted by the Planning and Zoning Commission in 2012. The plan entails the development/redevelopment of a 92 acre property located in the Town Center owned by Ensign Bickford Realty. An application for the development of the project is currently pending before the Commission. The application describes a project consisting of in excess of 1 mm square feet of retail, office and residential construction.

A public hearing on the plan is open and the next meeting of the Commission is scheduled for September 29<sup>th</sup>. Information on the proposed plan is available on the Town's web site by clicking on "Avon Village Center Master Plan."
