Potential Sanitary Sewer Service for the RE: Paperchase Trail / Hurdle Fence Drive neighborhood

Dear Paperchase Trail and Hurdle Fence Drive Resident,

The Engineering Department has completed the design of the sanitary sewers for the Paperchase Trail and Hurdle Fence Drive neighborhood and have split the neighborhood into two standalone projects. In order to have an accurate cost estimate for the project, we have gone out to bid for the southern project (see map attached). The bids are currently due to be submitted on June 9, 2016. This should give the Engineering Department enough time to evaluate the bids, determine if there are discrepancies, and provide meaningful information to you, the neighborhood residents.

Accordingly, the Avon Water Pollution Control Authority (AWPCA) is conducting a Public Hearing and informational presentation on the project on June 23, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. at the Avon Town Hall Selectmen's Chambers. At that time, the Town will present the design, discuss cost estimates, and provide an informational packet of materials.

It is the intention of the AWPCA to hear your comments, questions and concerns at this meeting before deciding whether to pursue the project.

We have reached out to the Avon Water Company and based on the reactions received at the previous informational meeting it is unlikely that they will attend. We have heard back from Connecticut Natural Gas and they have indicated that they will attend and discuss their intentions and requirements relative to bringing natural gas to the neighborhood.

We look forward to presenting the project and receiving your feedback.
