## **Excavation Permit – Acknowledgement of Pavement Cut Requirements CONDITIONS of APPROVAL**

Depending on the project, Contractor is to mole under all pavements including driveway aprons. If refused after 3 unique attempts, the Engineering Department must be contacted and approval obtained <u>BEFORE</u> open trench excavation.
Projects requiring open trenching, within pavement must be witnessed by Town of Avon Engineering Department for compaction and paving operations at a minimum. Town Road cuts require the two-part pavement restoration as defined within Avon's Pavement Cut Policy and Details. It is the Contractor's responsibility to acquire and understand the policy prior to commencing the work.
Trench backfilling and paving not witnessed by the Town of Avon $\underline{\textit{WILL}}$ result in the re-excavating and paving of location by Contractor.
Where possible, road crossings are to be at 90° to road and moled where possible.
Driveway apron cutting requirements:
a. <b>Property Owner Notification</b> - verbally and in writing at least 2 days prior to work. A copy of written notifications is to be provided to the Avon Engineering Department prior to the work.
b. <b>Apron Replacement</b> – Unless the apron is found to be in excellent condition by Town staff, aprons that are cut are to be replaced in kind from the right-of-way line to the roadway and in accordance with Avon's standard detail. All related work is to be witnessed by Avon Engineering. Property owners impacted are to be notified in advance
c. <b>Driveways less than 5 years old</b> – the seam of existing to new pavement is to be infrared-bonded to Town standards and witnessed by Avon Engineering staff.
