- “Let’s Roll” at 11:45a.m. as Avon’s first responders and Hometown Heroes lead the way from Pine Grove Elementary School into Sycamore Park, where the Lions Club has planned an outdoor family-friendly event providing the community with the opportunity to honor our local heroes from the Avon Volunteer Fire Department, Avon Police Department, American Red Cross, and local emergency services. There will be food trucks, activities & games for the kids, as well as fire trucks and police cars for them to touch and explore.
- Award reception from 5:30–8:30p.m recognizing Hometown Heroes at the Belle Ballroom, the North House, Avon, CT. Tickets are \$75 per person which includes food, soft drinks, alcoholic beverages, tax & gratuity.
