- Complete a public outreach and needs assessment process to identify and prioritize indoor/outdoor community needs in the short, medium, and long term
- Develop a strategic plan for improving existing facilities and/or constructing new facilities to meet community needs, safety, accessibility, and equity
- Outline a potential implementation process to include funding and phasing strategies



What is your one wish to Shape the Future of Avon Recreation & Parks?




Word Clouds: The bigger the text the more often the word appeared in the responses.






























There are not enough basketball courts to meet the needs of the basketball teams practice times- they are often late in the evening or limited times for coaches.










Q19: If you DO NOT use outdoor facilities or participate in outdoor programs offered by the Town of Avon, what is the primary reason? Choose all that apply.










