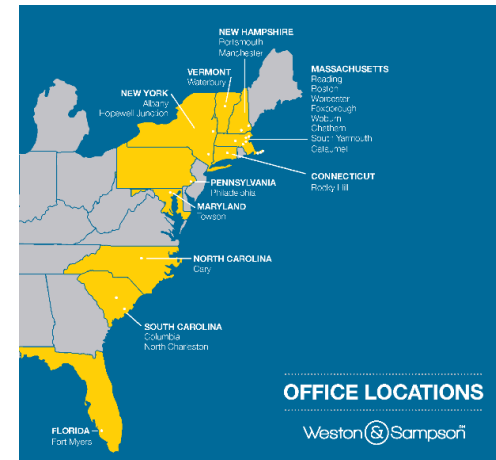

- Review and update an **inventory** and **analysis** of specific athletic fields, courts, and indoor recreational facilities.
- Complete a **public outreach** and **needs assessment** process to identify and prioritize indoor/outdoor community needs in the short, medium, and long term
- Develop a **strategic plan** for improving existing facilities and/or constructing new facilities to meet community needs, safety, accessibility, and equity
- Outline a potential **implementation process** to include funding and phasing strategies

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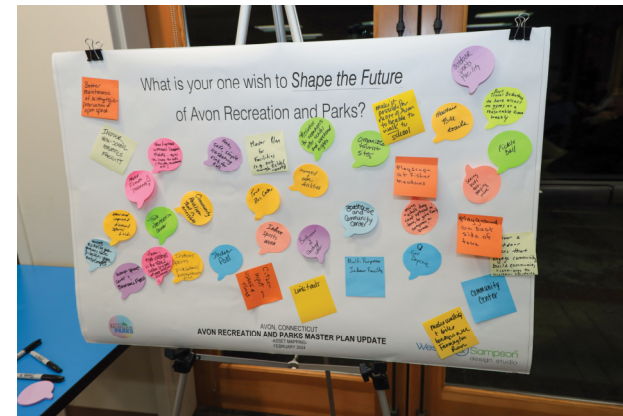


FINDINGS - PUBLIC MEETING #1: ASSET MAPPING RESULTS

- What barriers limit your participation or access to Town assets?

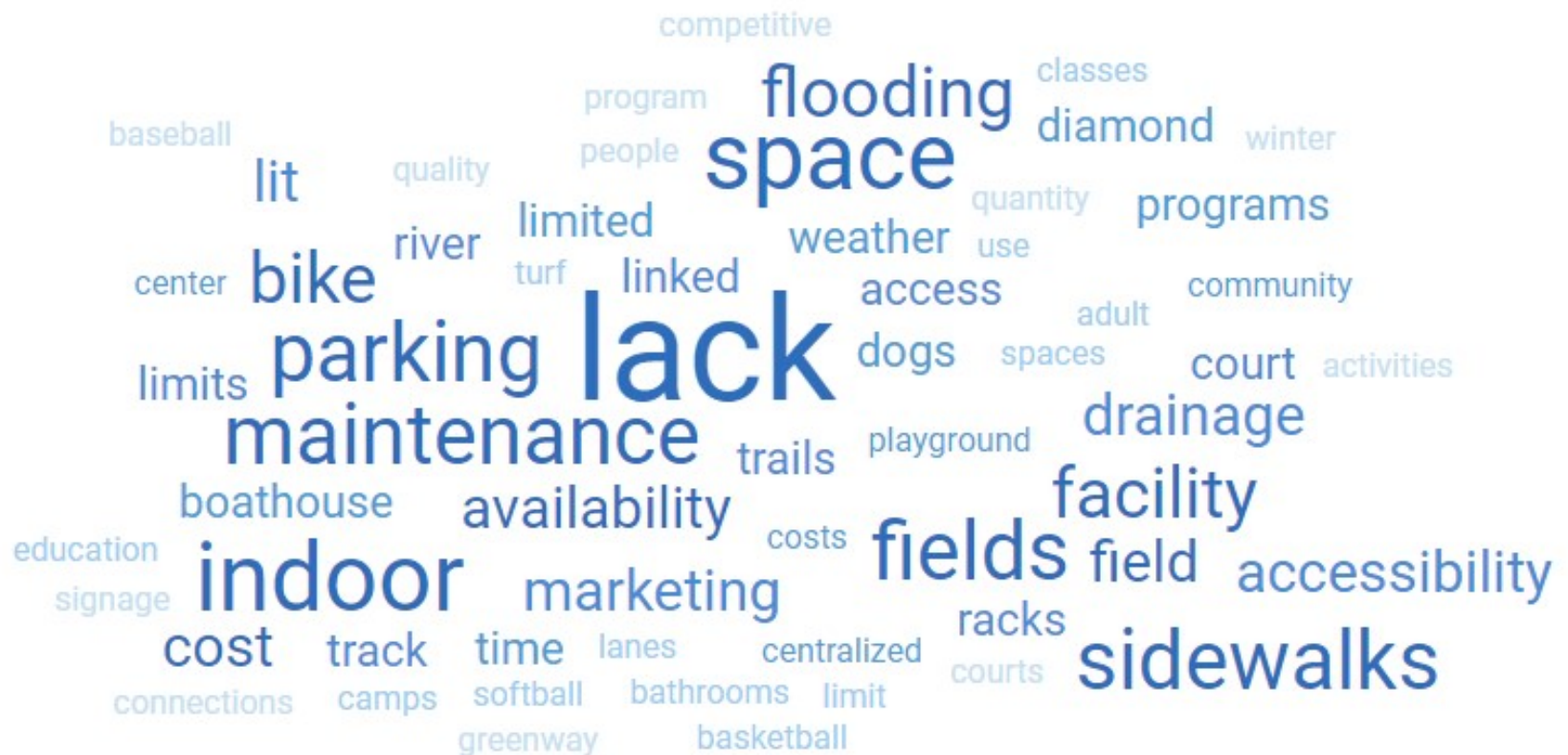

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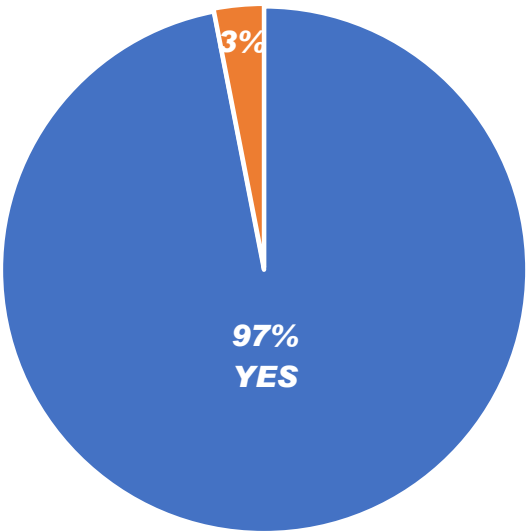

Q1: Do you live in Avon, CT?

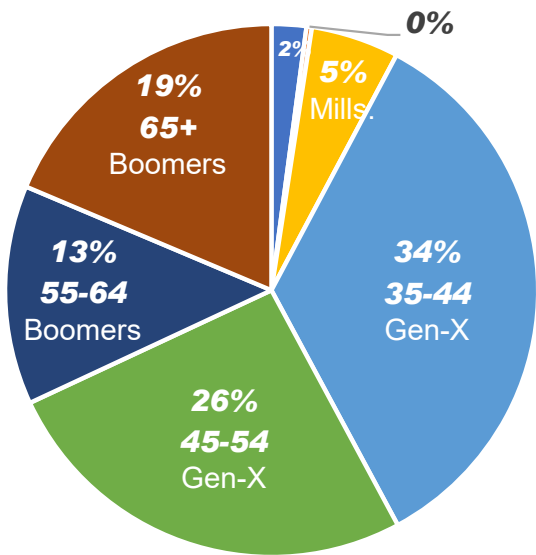

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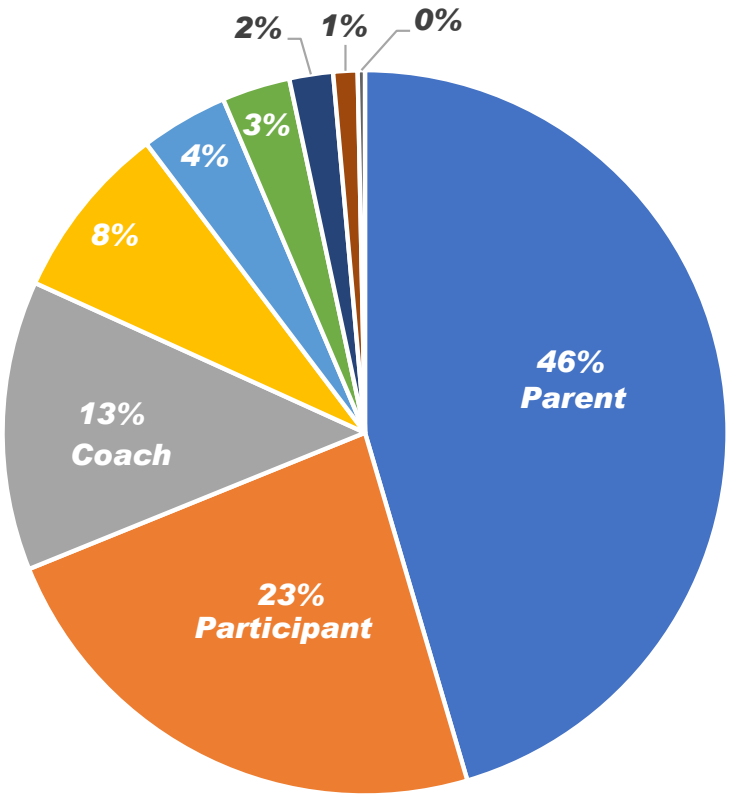

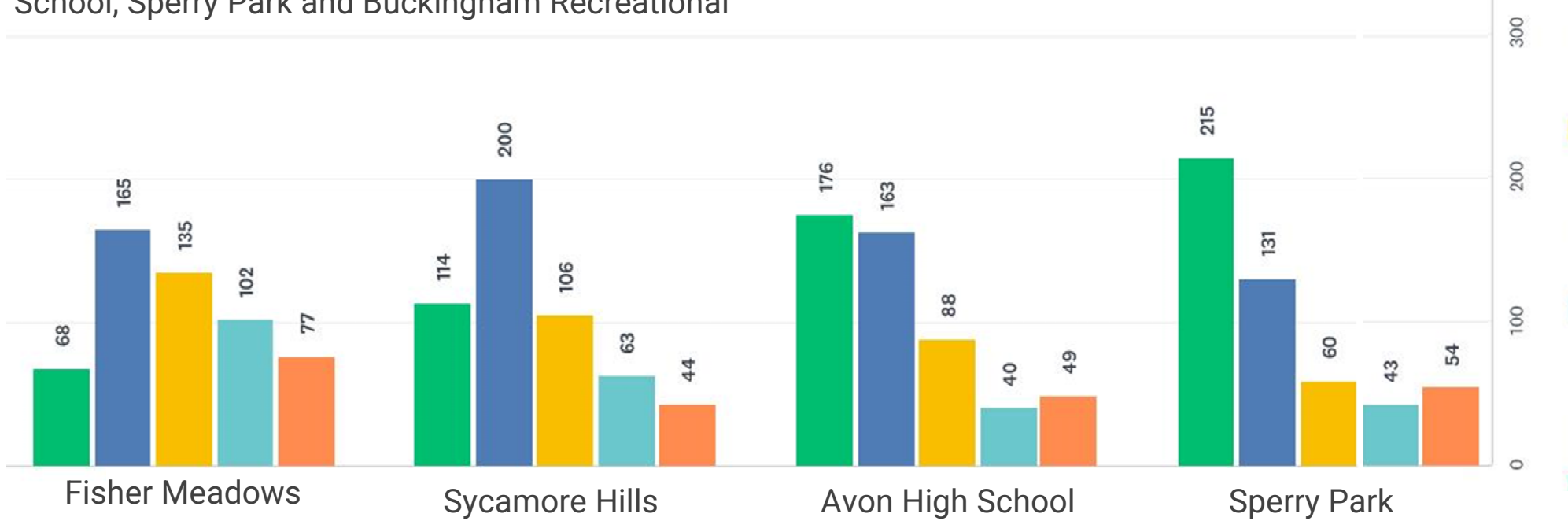

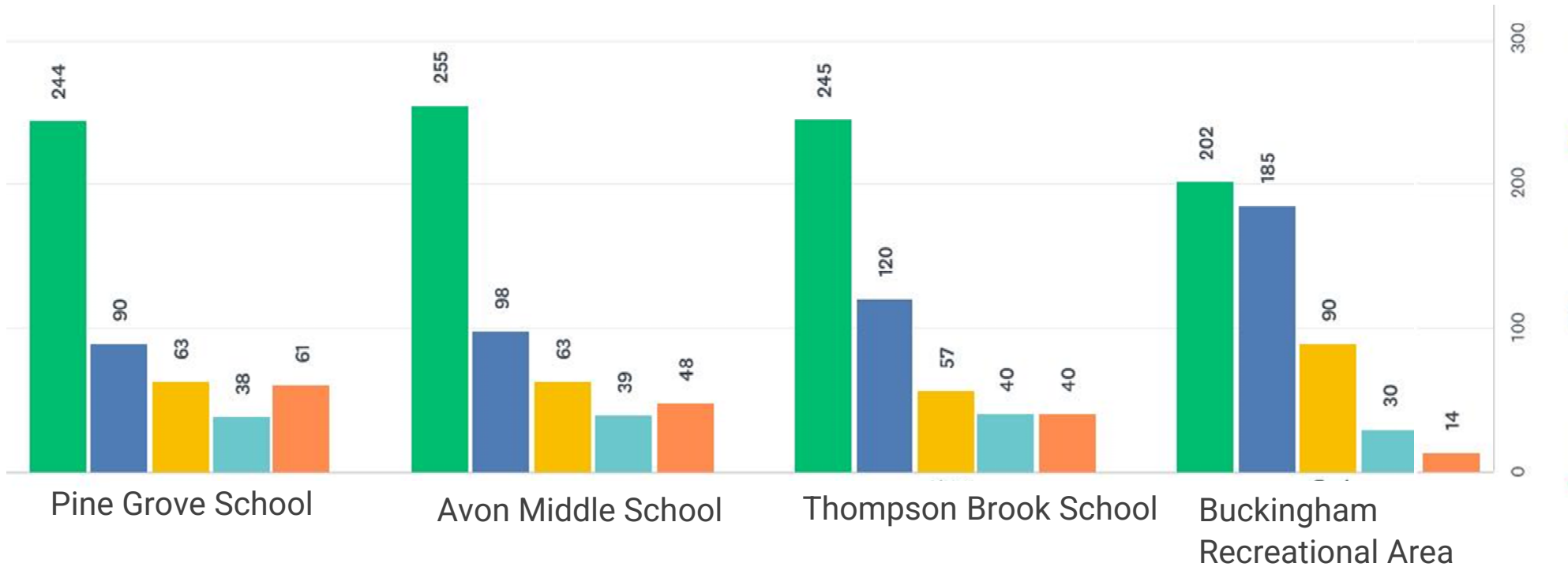

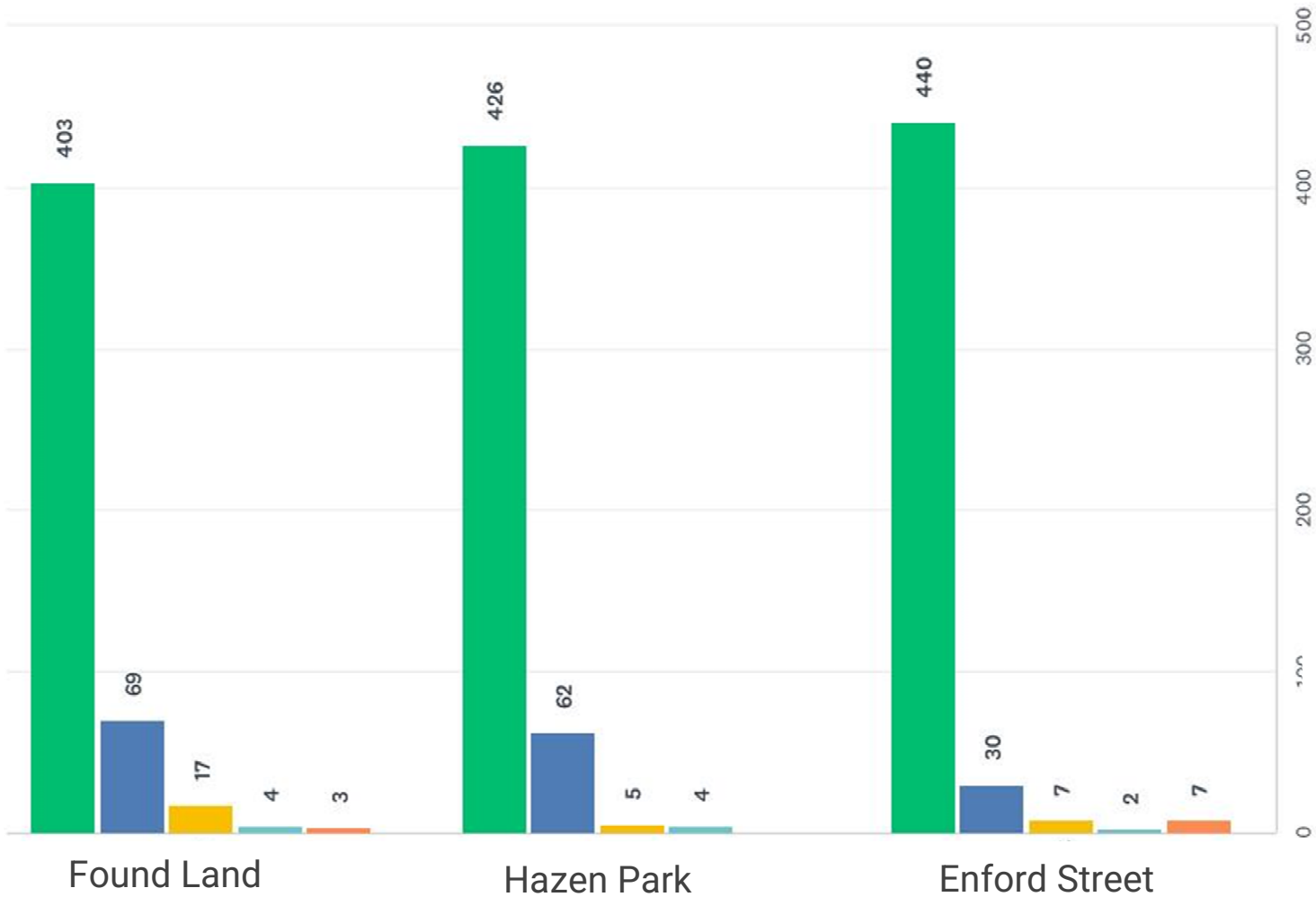

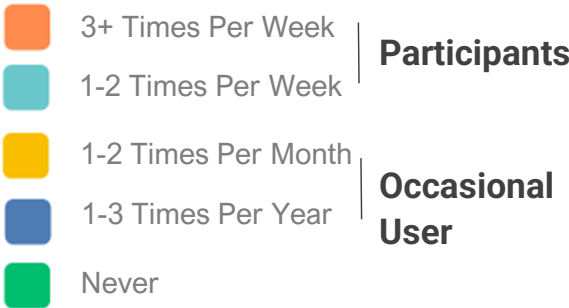
Q6: How often do you visit the following Town of Avon Parks and Facilities (outside of attendance for school/ work)? Answered: 565 Skipped: 55

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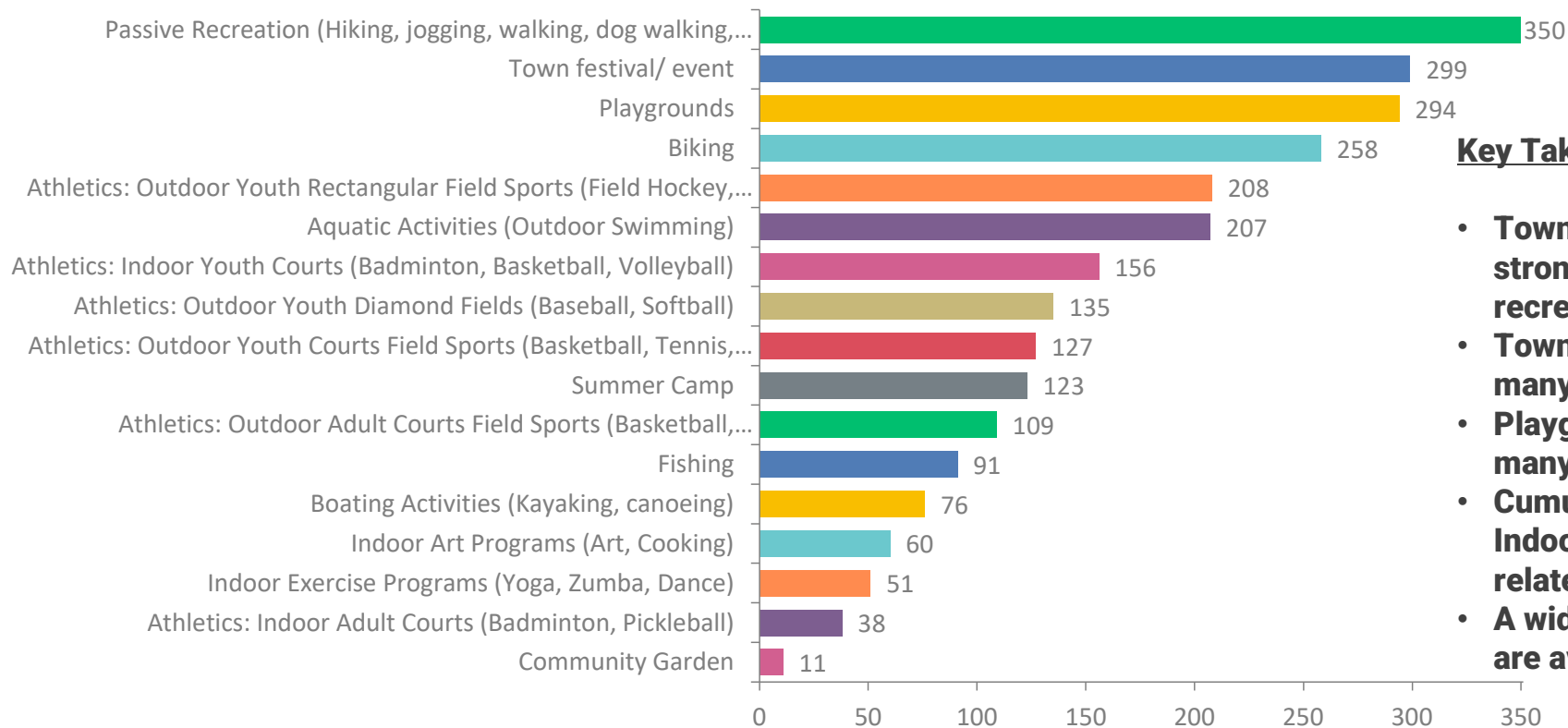

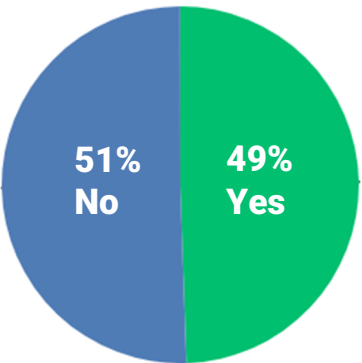


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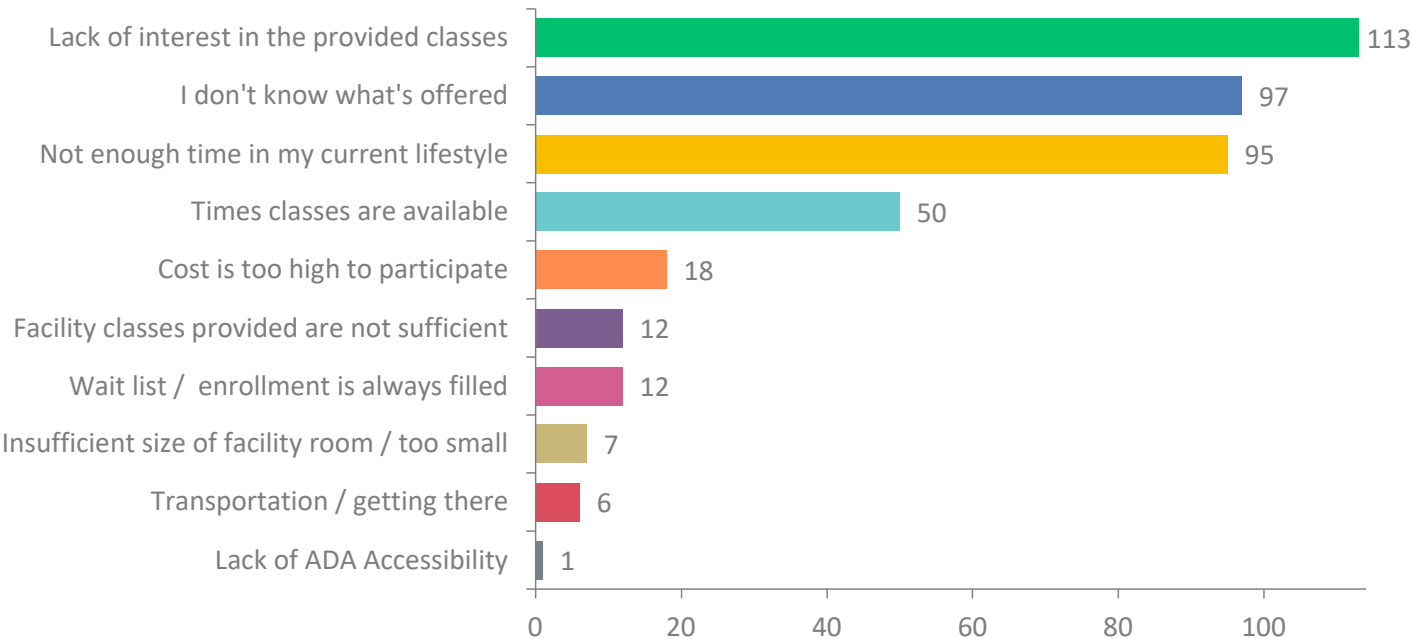

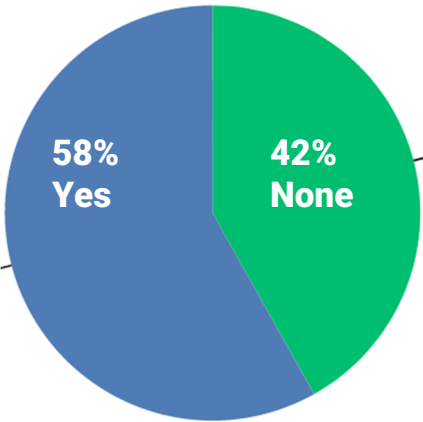

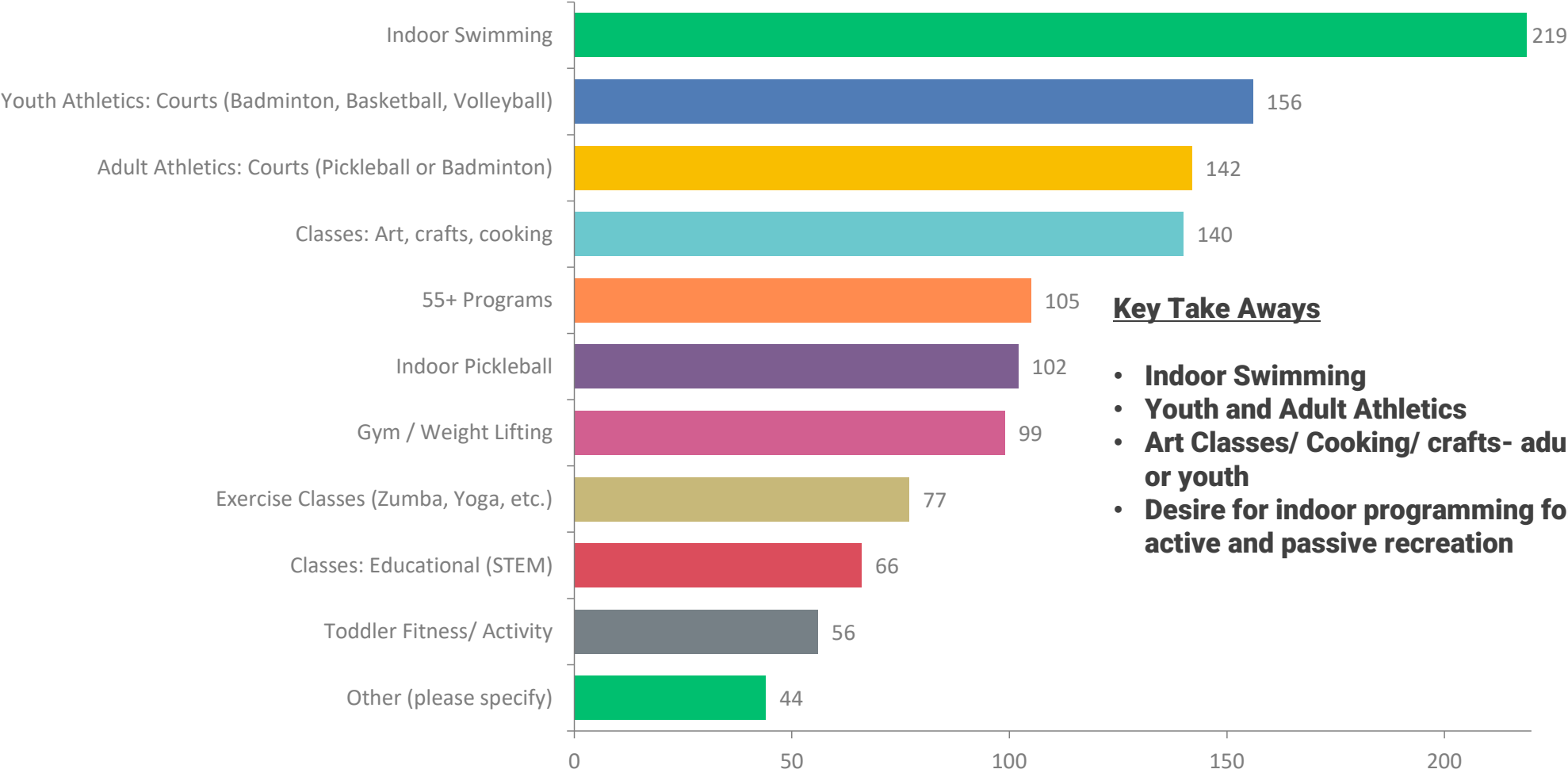

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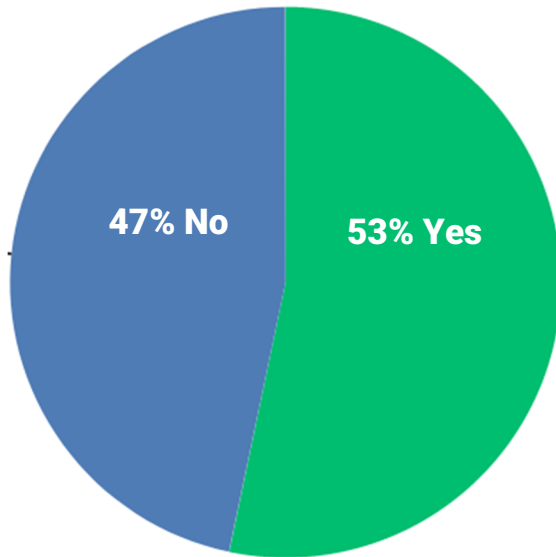

I would like to see a **variety of indoor classes**

Indoor pool is desired

There is **not enough space** available in which to schedule various classes that would meet multiple times weekly; eg yoga, Zumba and other exercise programs

Not enough availability of indoor spaces for sports, pickleball, badminton, table tennis, gatherings for people of any age. **Not enough places for teens to gather** for safe activities.

We **need community indoor meeting spaces**

I would like to support the Town of Avon and **spend my money here** verse spending money at facilities outside of Avon

Nothing for younger children in terms of indoor play activities or camps

It would be nice to have **an indoor pool for year round swimming.** I also think there should be a nicer facility to have community gatherings and events. There aren't any facilities that are useful for anyone in the **arts/ theater**

There **are not enough basketball courts to meet the needs** of the basketball teams practice times- they are often late in the evening or limited times for coaches.

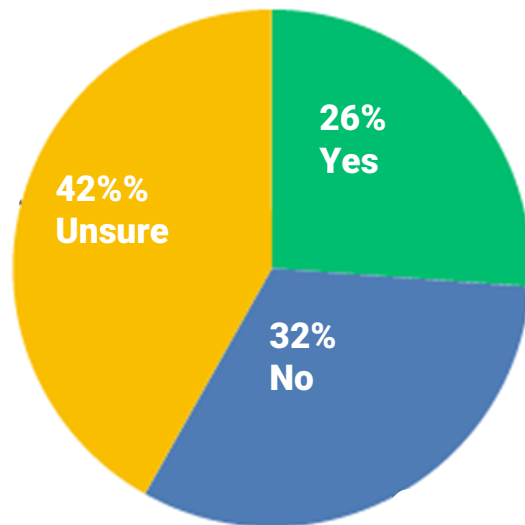

Q15: Do you feel that the existing community room at the Senior Center meets the needs of the community as a whole? Answered: 490 Skipped: 130



Last time I tried to utilize the room for an event, for a local organization, the **cost** of the rental was **too high**

It's in **walking distance to many schools** and could be used as an after school recreational area with indoor games and outdoor options at Sycamore.

The programming is largely **geared to** daytime and **seniors** only.

There are so many groups wanting to use the room, which makes it **hard to reserve**

I was not clear that the community room was available for all Avon residents, **I thought it was for seniors**

I'd love to see an update and **expansion** of offerings **for all** – both youth and adult programs. I'd **also love more family programs** to participate together as a family

I think the community room does not meet the needs of the community because it is **too small**

I wish the Senior Center had **more** breakout rooms for a **variety** of programs

It's **not large enough, versatile enough**, nor does it promote enough physical activity

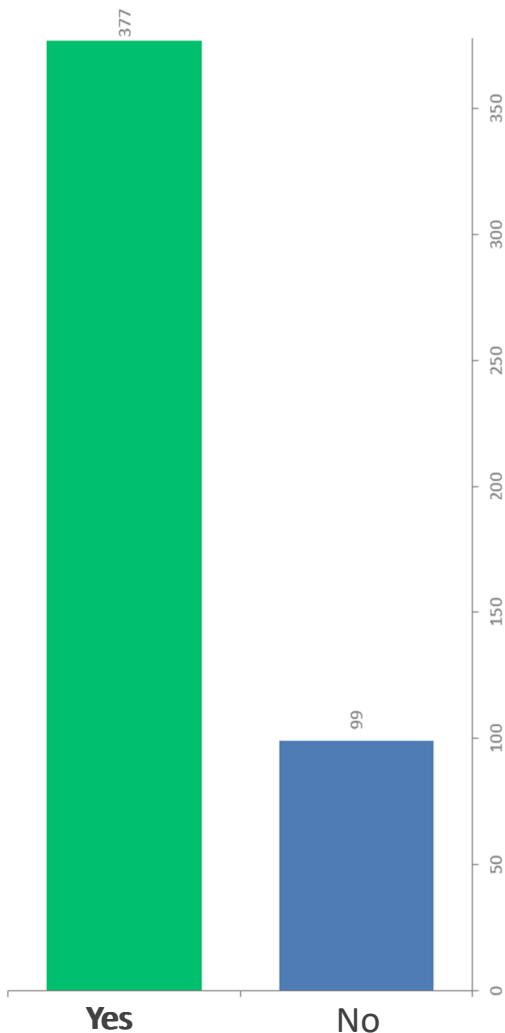

The size of **youth athletics** is **constantly growing** and gym space is hard to come by. Teams are sharing court time & shortening practices to accommodate everyone.

There are two gyms **nearby** and several **facilities** that offer programming. I am not sure how the facility would benefit the Town.

Rather that utilize schools and coordinate with their events it would be nice if we had a **dedicated recreational area** for Recreation and Parks use

With such a **high need of athletic options for adults and youth**, it would be advisable to expand moving forward.

While dedicated space is always preferable, the **Town does not lack the amenities** for most activities. Redundant space, centralized, isn't needed in a Town of this size.

We should **enhance the indoor facilities at our schools**. Adding another big expensive building that will require maintenance and management

There **needs to be a place** where **youth and teens can go to** engage in healthy activities after school and on weekends. There **needs to be places where older adults can gather** to engage in activities.

Avon really doesn't have a Town Center. I think an **indoor recreational facility** could possibly be a **good gathering space for the community** and be that town center that we are lacking

This would allow more people to **use the facility all year round** and have a single location for many recreational and athletic activities instead of going to neighboring Towns. This will also **help the Town** in my opinion to **stand out** among neighboring Towns and be ready for the future

Just **improve what we have**.

I think we **have space at the schools**, we just need the Town to run the programs not private clubs/teams.

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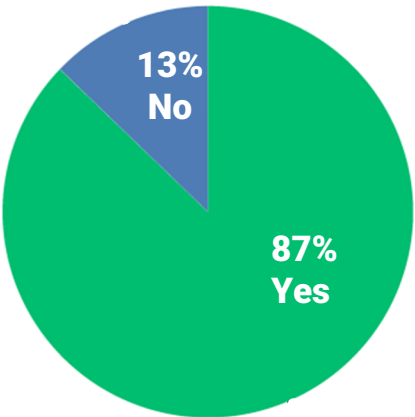

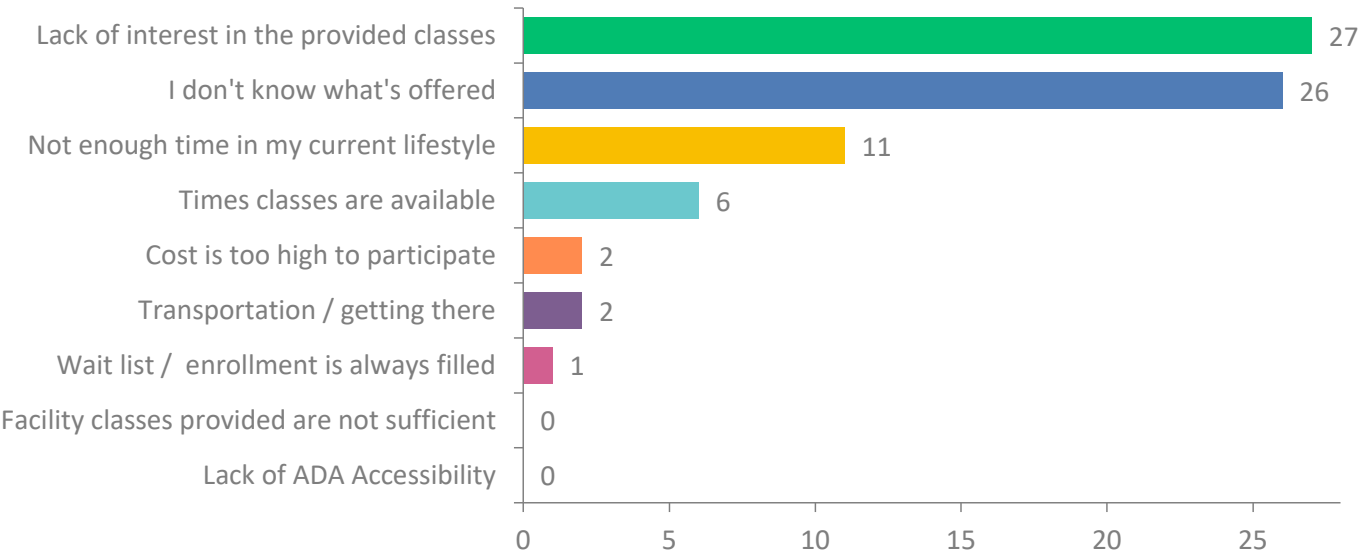
Q18: Do you use outdoor facilities or programs offered by the Town of Avon?

Q19: If you DO NOT use outdoor facilities or participate in outdoor programs offered by the Town of Avon, what is the primary reason? Choose all that apply.

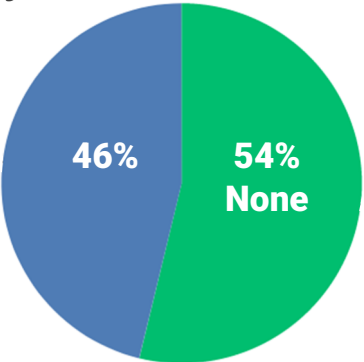

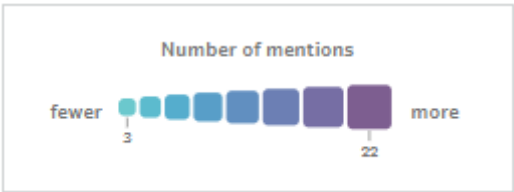

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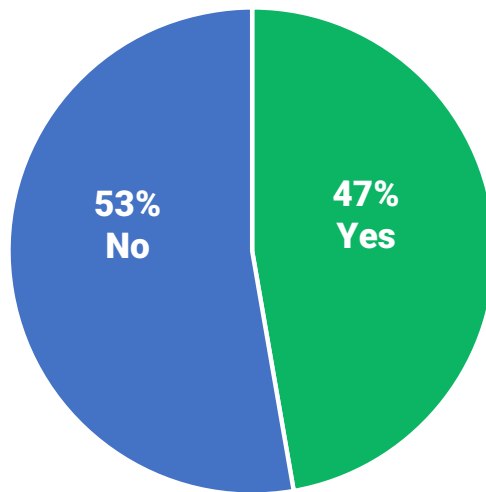

The **amount of time/ money spent in upkeep is inadequate.** A lot of parks, trails, outdoor features are overgrown and encroached by the surrounding woods.

I wish there were **more walkable area**

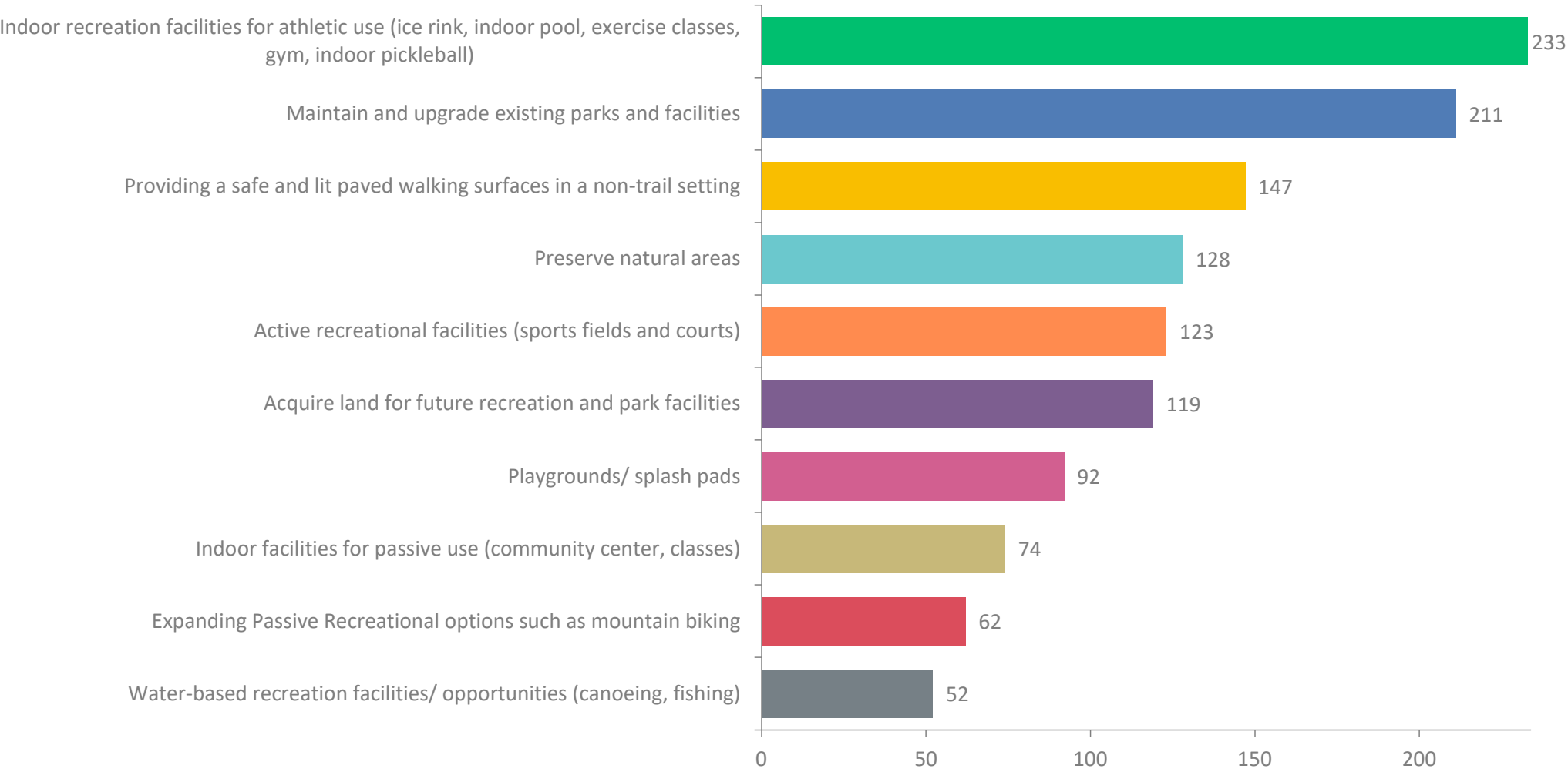

FINDINGS – INVENTORY & NEEDS ASSESSMENT: OUTDOOR FEEDBACK

Fields remain unplayable for multiple days due to **poor drainage and field maintenance**

With growth in both boy and girl sports, we are in **desperate need of added field space to provide equitable opportunities** in a safe and organized way

Available overflow fields are **not maintained and unsafe**

There are many **scheduling conflicts** between high school sports and many sports needing to use the same field

We **limit registration** due to lack of available fields

We have plenty of rectangular fields in Town, but they don't drain well so they **remain unplayable for a long period of time**

Turning **away opportunities** to host district and all – star games

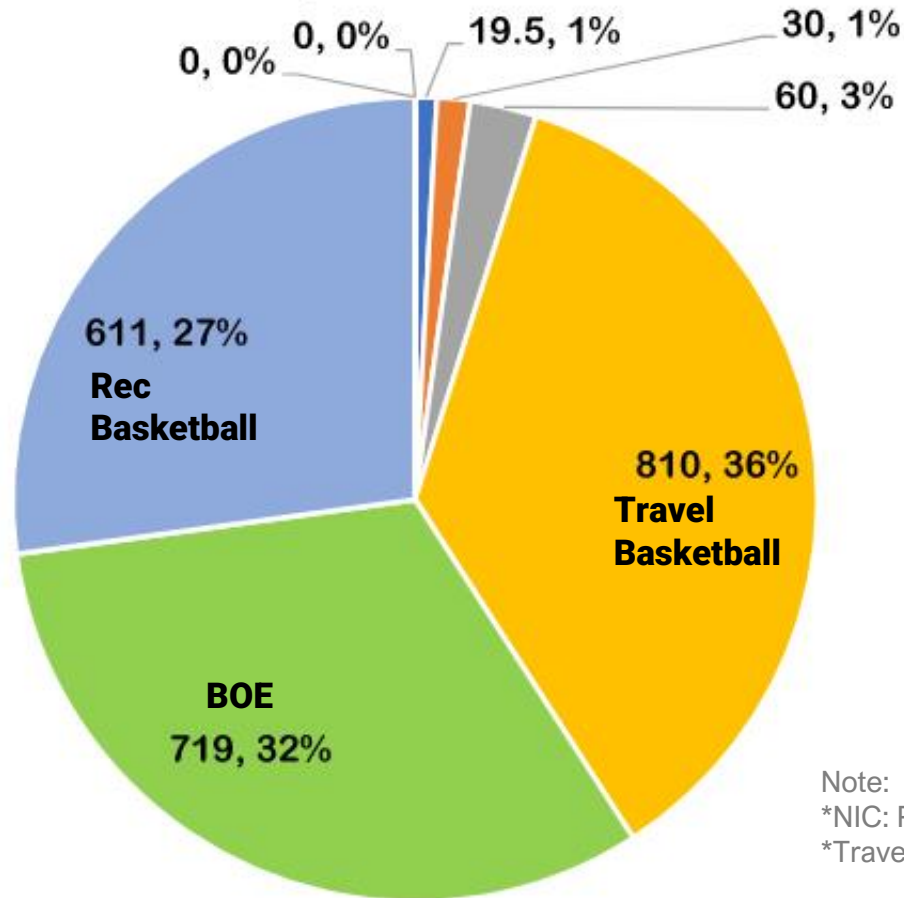

No indoor space to accommodate winter clinics

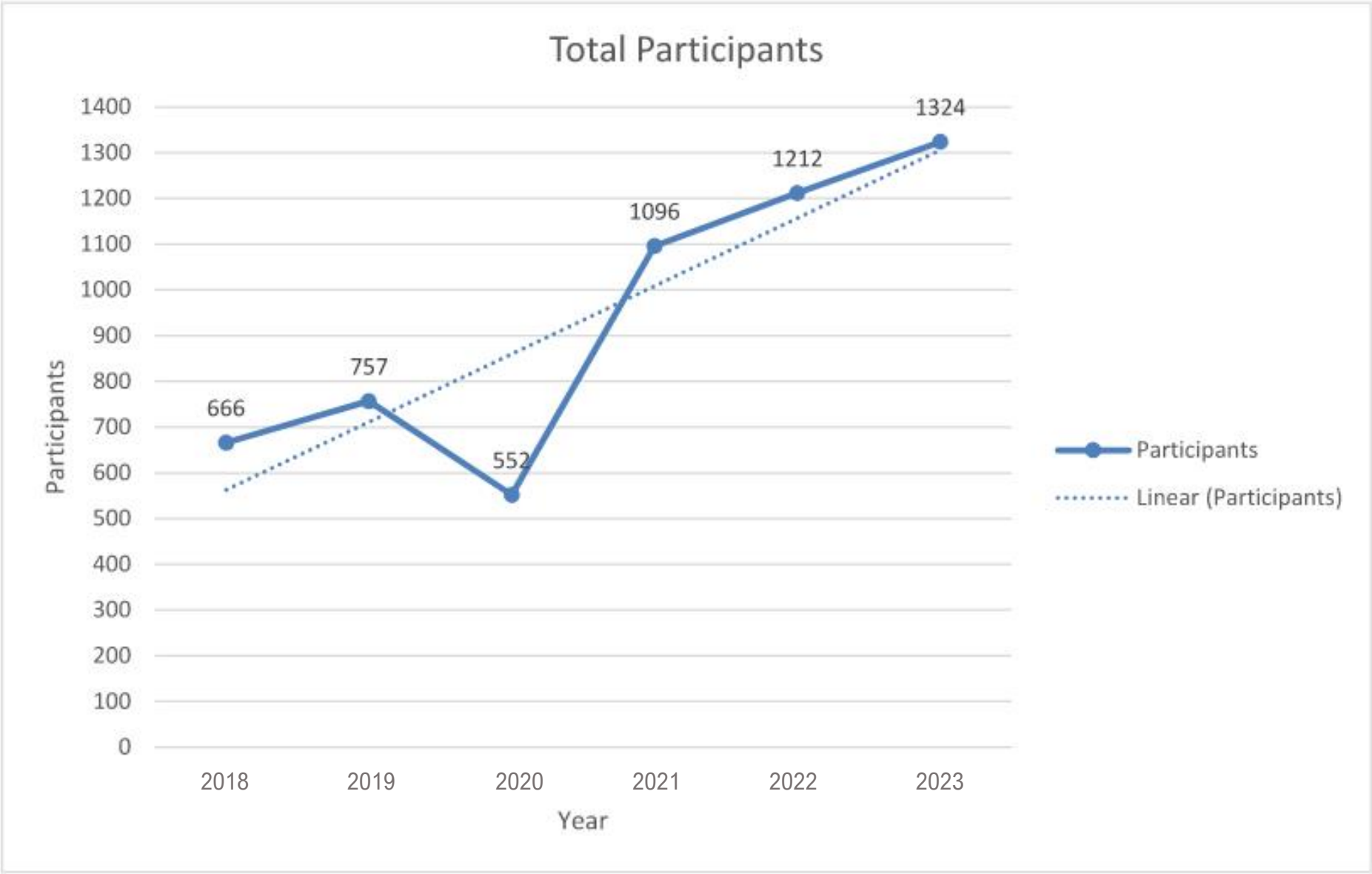
