
## GENERAL FUND

The General Fund is used to account for most of Avon's current operating expenditures, including Capital Outlay purchases (less than \$20,000 in value, with a life expectancy of five years or less), and debt requirements. The General Fund receives the majority of its revenue from property taxes. The graphs below, and on the following page, reflect both the major sources of revenue and objects of expenditure and the percentage component of the total for the fiscal year 2023/2024 General Fund Appropriations. The fiscal year 2023/2024 column includes Town and Board of Education.
