The Special Projects Committee of the Avon Historical Society is pleased to present the third installment of a year-long lecture series focusing on local agriculture and farm families. Professor Kathy Hermes, CCSU professor of history, will present something new and exciting in the local history realm-a computer program called 'Digital Farmington' at the Avon Senior Center. She spearheaded the creation of 'Digital Farmington' after consultation with the Stanley-Whitman House, to create a program that would be useful for tourism in highlighting historic sites in Farmington. Avon, formerly part of Farmington, is a natural extension with additional historic sites that now lie within the boundaries of the Town of Avon, have been added to the program. 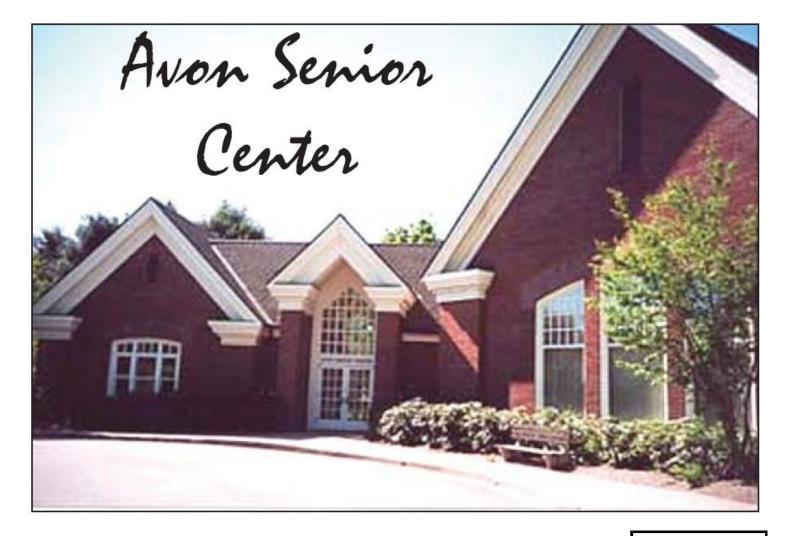
