Please let us know if you want to be added to our CRT grab & go lunch list. Each person receives two frozen meals plus fruit, milk & other sides. Pick up is Thursdays at 12:00 p.m. You drive up and we will

hand the meals to you while you're in your vehicle for safe social distancing. There are no Congregate in-person meals at this time.





Contact tracing is key to slowing the spread of COVID-19 and helps protect you, your family, and your community by:

- \* Letting people know they may have been exposed to COVID-19, should monitor their health for signs and symptoms of COVID-19,
- \* Helping people who may have been exposed to COVID-19 get tested, and
- \* Asking people to self-isolate or self-quarantine to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19 to others.

#### **Green flags**

#### Contact tracers:

- \* Be state or local Department of Health employees or their contractors,
- \* Ask about your personal symptoms to gauge for possible COVID-19 infection,
  - \* Recent contact with others,
  - \* Refer you to other medical & social resources,
- \* Ask whether you have insurance so they can connect those who are not insured with resources.

#### Red flags

Be cautious of anyone who:

- \* Asks for specifics about your health insurance, like your Medicare number,
- \* Claims they need a credit card or cash to pay for a COVID-19 test, or
- \* Wants your personal information to help you set up a COVID-19 test.

# How Can Your Senior Medicare Patrol (SMP) Help?

Your local SMP is will provide you with information you need to **PROTECT** yourself from Medicare fraud, errors, and abuse; **DETECT** potential fraud, errors, and abuse; and **REPORT** your concerns. SMPs & trained teams help educate & empower Medicare beneficiaries in the fight against health care fraud. Your SMP can help you with questions, concerns, or complaints about potential fraud and abuse issues. It also can provide information and educational presentations.

### Enroll to Receive Emergency Updates from the Town of Avon!



The Town of Avon is committed to providing up to date information about storm preparations and emergencies. Below are three ways to make sure that you stay up-to-date when weather and emergencies strike.

<u>SUBSCRIBE TO NEWS</u> - To receive regular email updates about Town business, "Subscribe to News" on the Town's website (https://www.avonct.gov/subscribe).

Select "Town Alerts" & "Town News and Announcements" to receive updates regarding storms, emergencies, and other timely news.

<u>CT ALERTS</u> - To receive critical emergency information sign up for the CTAlert system (https://portal.ct.gov/ctalert) which sends time-sensitive notices wherever you specify: home, cell, business, text messages, email, hearing impaired receiving devices & more. <u>Both the State of</u>

# CT and the Town of Avon have the ability to send alerts to those registered with the CTAlert system.

When the State or the Town issues a message about an emergency, the message will be sent to all numbers & email addresses enrolled in the system in order of priority set by user. If you do not confirm receipt of the message, the system will attempt to reach your next contact entered into the system. The Town suggests enrolling in both Subscribe to News and CTAlert to stay informed.
