About a third of older Americans lived in poverty & there were few programs to meet their needs. Interest in older Americans & their concerns grew. A meeting in April 1963 between President John F.
Kennedy & members of the National Council of Senior Citizens led to designating May as "Senior Citizens Month," the prelude to "Older Americans Month."

Historically, Older Americans Month has been a time to acknowledge the contributions of past and current older persons to our country, in particular those who defended our country. Every President since Kennedy has issued a formal proclamation during or before the month of May asking that the entire nation pay tribute in some way to older persons in their communities.


David Eberle an accomplished pianist and teacher will entertain us.
