

Chapter 53 of the Town's Code of Ordinances, all construction work completed in the Town's right-of-way requires a permit from the Town's Engineering Department. <u>Obtain permit before</u> <u>work is performed.</u> Town may impose financial penalty for un-permitted work & <u>property</u> <u>owner</u> will be liable. 
